A few of the topics she will touch on is fraud within places of worship/non-profit organizations and fraud against senior citizens, specifically Medicare/health care and insurance fraud, funeral and cemetery fraud, fraudulent anti-aging products, investment and Reverse Mortgage fraud. She will talk about the current scams reported in Leelanau County such as the IRS scam and the medical lifeline scam that is fraudulently using the name of Munson Hospital in their ad. She will end the program with advice on how to come up with secure passwords and safe credit card tips.

Lowell Jacobsen, “Jake”, a retired Leelanau County Deputy and computer forensics examiner will also share his fraud and scam knowledge.
