National Speaker Ben Cort: Mr. Cort travels the country to speak on the negative effects of marijuana legalization in his home state of Colorado. He is the Director of Business Development/CeDAR at the University of Colorado Hospital and runs the Colorado Center for Dependency, Addiction and Rehabilitation. His center has seen an increase in admissions of adults seeking treatment for marijuana use as the state's laws on marijuana have loosened. Ben, who is in recovery, is a junior fellow at the University of Florida's Drug Policy Institute and serves on the board of SAM (Smart Approaches to Marijuana), a bipartisan group that advocates a 'health-first' approach to marijuana policy.
